## Parties Financing and Political Corruption as an Organized Corruption in Indonesia

Reformation Order gives great impacts in every aspect of people and government in Indonesia. People demands cleaner and more accountable government, therefore law provides greater rights for people to vote for the person and party, they like most, through National election and regional elections.
