



Announcement of the Bureau of Human Resource Management
Subject: Avoid Accepting All Kinds of Presents and Gifts from Performing Duties Policy
(No Gift Policy)
Fiscal year B.E. 2569 (A.D. 2026)

The Bureau of Human Resource Management has duties and power to prevent and suppress corruption and misconduct in accordance with the Organic Act on Anti-Corruption B.E. 2561 (A.D. 2018). The primary goal is to solve corruption problems in Thailand. It is in line with the core concept of National Strategy B.E. 2561-2580 (A.D. 2018-2037); Master Plan under the National on Anti-Corruption and Misconduct, as well as the National Reform Plan on Anti-Corruption and Misconduct.

The Bureau of Human Resource Management pays attention to the reformation that will result in significantly changes for the people, as well as improve the Thai bureaucratic system to be fair, transparent and enhance good governance. Furthermore, the Bureau of Human Resource Management supports and promotes personnel ethics and maintains standard disciplinary procedures within the organization to be a role model. These will promote the perception of positive image of the agency and build trust form the people. It contributes to the agency's performance of duties of prevention and suppression of corruption with rapidity, fairness, honesty, professional, transparency and accountability, without the misbehavior of exercising public power for personal again. In this regard, to manifest this intention, the Bureau of Human Resource Management announces its commitment that all executives and officers will not accept all kinds of presents and gifts, regardless during, before and after performing duties (No Gift Policy), which will cause corruption and misconduct, and also comply with the Notification of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the Criteria of the Acceptance of Assets or Other Benefits on Ethical Basis of the Public Official B.E. 2563 (A.D. 2020) as well
