

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

The Office of the National Counter Corruption Commission

&

Administrative Control Authority of Egypt

Concerning the exchange of expertise and information

in the field of combating corruption

The Office of the National Counter Corruption Commission of Thailand and the Administrative Control Authority of Egypt , hereinafter referred to as " the Parties " ;

Recognising the gravity of problems caused by corruption that might threaten the stability of the society and its security and destroy social, economic, political and democratic values;

Desiring to establish relations between them in areas of common concern;

Considering their shared perception that the said reciprocal exchange of expertise, views and information will strengthen professionalism and efficiency of the Parties;

Acting in accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations of their respective countries;

Have agreed as follows:

Article 1

Objective

The Parties shall establish cooperation between them with the view to increasing capabilities and skills of their staff members in combating corruption.

Article 2

Exchange of information

The Parties shall exchange information in respect of methods and means of criminal acts of corruption and/or corrupt practices including matters relating to money laundering and proceeds of crimes of corruption

Article 3

Training

The Parties shall determine the modalities of cooperation concerning the training of the staff members of Administrative Control Authority and Office of the National Counter Corruption Commission in combating corruption or any other topics to be agreed upon between them.

Article 4

Exchange of delegation

The Parties shall exchange visits of their respective delegations on the basis of reciprocity. The composition of each delegation and the period of visit, as well as the terms and conditions of each visit, shall be agreed upon between the Parties.

Article 5

Expenses

The sending Party shall cover the travel expenses and daily allowance of its delegation. The receiving Party shall cover the cost of accommodation and domestic transportation of the sending Party's delegation.

Article 6

Address

Article 7

Amendments

This MOU may be amended by written mutual consent of the Parties.

Article 8

Entry into Force

This MOU shall come into force on the date of the later notification by the Parties informing each other that their respective domestic requirements for entering into force of this MOU have been completed.

Article 9

The Duration

The duration of this MOU is 3 years, which may be extended for a further period of 3 years on mutual written agreement of the Parties.

Article 10

The Termination

This MOU may be terminated at any time by either Party informing the other Party in writing of its intention to terminate it. The termination shall take effect 6 months from the date of the receipt of the notification.

Article 11


General Provisions

1. Cooperation activities under this MOU shall be conducted by the Parties in accordance with their respective laws and legislations.
2. It is not authorized for either Party to transmit information exchanged between the Parties under this MOU to a third party without written consent from the other Party.
