

## The Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission Cooperates with Educational Agencies to Create Core Curriculum in Corruption Prevention



On 29th May 2017, the sub-committee on creating curriculum or kit of learning materials and educational media of corruption prevention comprises of Assoc. Prof. Dr. Manee Chaiteeranuatsiri, Advisor to NACC President, Chair, administrative of the Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission (ONACC), representative from educational authorities related to curriculum design, including experts both from public and private sectors held at the ONACC. The meeting aimed to design curriculum or kit of learning materials and educational media of corruption prevention to set as core curriculum for educational institution to apply and implement in their context. The highlight of this curriculum is to instill conscience on differentiation between public and private interest, shame on corruption, intolerance of corruption, self-sufficiency against corruption, and citizenship that is responsible for corruption problems of the country. In addition, this curriculum is also in conformity to the National Anti-Corruption Strategy Phase 3 (2017 – 2021) strategy 1: “create a Society Which Does Not Tolerate Corruption”.

The meeting also mutually agreed to assign educational institutions and agencies to study the educational content harmonious with the National Anti-Corruption Strategy. The outcome of these studies will lead to two workshops on creating curriculum or kit of learning materials and educational media in regards to corruption prevention provided that the result will be disseminated to every level of educational institutions to try out to the target groups.
